



#### • English (Jesus) -1630 to present

- The name Jesus is actually not that old. It has been used for less than 400 years, and this name was not even present in the very first 1611 King James version bible. The name Jesus first appeared in the year 1630.
- According to quora.com "The first time the English Jesus was spelled precisely in this way in a sacred sense was 1630-1631. The first time the English name Jesus was spelled precisely in this way in a secular sense was first noted June of 1632 within an English legal brief prepared from the Court of High Commission in London England". It has been proven and it has been dated that the name Jesus came AFTER the 1611 KJV bible. The 1611 bible was the bible that was for the church of England and it was commissioned in the year of 1603 and then published in the year 1611.

The name Jesus was a transliteration. A transliteration means to replace the letters of a word with the corresponding letters in another alphabet. Words may be transliterated into the Roman alphabet from their originals in Greek, Japanese, Chinese, etc. The result is a transliteration which preserves the form of the original, as distinct from a translation, which gives the equivalent word, (often unrelated in form) in another language. For example, pteron is a transliteration from Greek, and wing is its translation. The name Jesus has been brought through transliteration three times. From the Hebrew name Yeshua to Greek name Ἰησοῦς, Greek to the Latin name leous and from Latin to the English name Jesus. So, when names are transliterated, they lose meaning, because a transliteration is a form of the original word. This is why the name Jesus has no meaning in the English language. This is why it is so important to know his true name as all names have meanings. Thoughout scripture we know that all the great men of Elohim names had meaning, so why would we take away the most important name in our faith? By removing his true name and giving him a name that means nothing.

- The same is for the other transliterations, Ιησοῦς has no meaning in Greek and leous has no meaning in Latin as it relate's to our Massiah. We will discuss these names in detail and the break down each name with some disturbing facts. Next we will look up the origins or beginnings of all the names associated with the Messiah. Starting off with Jesus Wikipedia states,
- "Jesus (IPA: /ˈdʒiːzəs/) is a masculine given name derived from the name lēsous (Greek: Ἰησοῦς), the Greek form of the Hebrew name Yeshua or Y'shua (Hebrew: ישוע).[1][2] As its roots lie in the name Yeshua/Y'shua, it is etymologically related to another biblical name, Joshua. "Jesus" is usually not used as a given name in the English-speaking world, while its counterparts have had longstanding popularity among people with other language backgrounds, such as the Spanish Jesús."

So we can see the name Jesus came from the derived form of the Greek name Ἰησοῦς. Well we know that the Greek, English and Latin names don't have any meaning. Why would the Yah of all creation have a meaningless name? This doesn't make sense. In Matthew chapter 1 verse 20-23 reads:

20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

21And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name Yahawashi: **for he shall** save his people from their sins.

22Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,

23Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us..

- Even the Prophet Ahaz was giving the "divine sign" to the name and with meaning of the Messiah. This precept can be found in Isaiah 7:14. Emmanuel means Yah is with us. And we know the Messiah being the Son of Yah walking among us. So, we know His name has meaning.
- Reading further we will see the constructed name of Jesus has no meaning to the name Yeshua/ Yahawashi. This name is etymologically nonrelated to the name Joshua, which is the true translation of the Messiah name in English.
- Etymology is the study of the origin, prefix, root and suffix of words and how their meanings have changed through history.

- "From the Hebrew name יָהוֹשָׁע (Yehoshu'a/Yahawashi) meaning "YAHWEH is salvation", from the roots יהו (yeho) referring to the Hebrew God and ישׁע (yasha') meaning "to save". As told in the Old Testament, Joshua was a companion of Moses. He went up Mount Sinai with Moses when he received the Ten Commandments from God, and later he was one of the twelve spies sent into Canaan. After Moses died Joshua succeeded him as leader of the Israelites and he led the conquest of Canaan. His original name was *Hoshea*." Then name Joshua is the English name for the Hebrew name Yahawashi or for short Yeshua
- Again... why would the early forefathers of the early Greek and Latin scribes make the decisions to make this change losing the meaning and converting to a name of transliteration.

So let's talk about the Latin Jesus

## Latin (lesus)

So, If Gentiles where not his people.... Not apart of the faith... and Yahawashi did not come to redeem them, then why is the name of our Messiah be converted to a meaning that is under so much controversy?

### Greek *lesous* (Ἰησοῦς),

- When you look up this name all you get is the etymology.
- This is the Greek name for the Latin name lesus.

### Ancient Aramaic (Yeshua)

• **Yeshua** (ישוע, with vowel pointing ישׁוּע – yēšūă' in Hebrew) was a common alternative form of the name יְהוֹשֵׁע ("Yehoshua" – Joshua) in later books of the Hebrew Bible and among Jews of the Second Temple period. The name corresponds to the Greek spelling *lesous* (Ἰησοῦς), from which, through the Latin *lesus*, comes the English spelling Jesus.

## Modern Hebrew (Yehoshua)

- Yehoshua is a Hebrew <u>surname</u> (A surname, family name, or last name is the portion (in some cultures) of a <u>personal name</u> that indicates a person's family (or tribe or community, depending on the culture), that is presumably derived directly from the English transliteration of יהושע, which means roughly "YHWH rescues" or "YHWH is salvation". [1][2]
- "Yehoshua" יהושע was also the Hebrew name for <u>Joshua</u> and has been used as a masculine <u>given name</u>.

#### **Ancient Hebrew**

- Yahawashi is an ancient Hebrew name for the Messiah. We can take a look at the ancient script to see the translation of the Massiah's name to Ancient Hebrew.
- "Yahawashi" (OwY = 1) was also the ancient Hebrew name for Joshua and has been used as the name Yah is our salvation.
